REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

“See Something, Say Something” encourages you to raise your awareness of people and activity around you.

If you see something suspicious on campus, contact Campus Safety. This is true in Siloam Springs in general, but we want to focus on our safety here at JBU.

Take these three action steps:

1. Report Suspicious Activity
2. Call or Text Campus Safety at 479-215-5000. Call 911 in case of emergencies
3. Describe Who, What, When, Where, Why

What classifies as suspicious activity?

As you observe your surroundings on campus, here are examples of suspicious activity that should be reported to Campus Safety:

- > Criminal/suspicious circumstances
- > Anyone forcibly entering a car or home
- > Someone tampering with property
- > Strangers loitering or entering rooms, offices or labs with no apparent legitimate cause
- > Someone carrying a weapon
- > Strange vehicles parked in your area
- > Any behavior that is out of character on a college campus
- > Packages left unattended and that are suspicious or have noxious odors

NOTE: It's important to understand that factors such as race, ethnicity, national origin or religious affiliation alone are not suspicious.

What do I say in a report?

After you've contacted either Campus Safety or local authorities, make sure you describe specifically what you observed using the 5 W's:

- > **Who** did you see?
- > **What** did you see?
- > **When** did you see it?
- > **Where** did it occur?
- > **Why** is it suspicious?
