- Hiring & Networking Fair: Out of an abundance of caution, we are canceling our upcoming [Hiring & Networking Fair](#) scheduled for Wednesday, March 18, 2020. We will provide refunds to all employers currently registered.
- For those who have scheduled interviews with students through our On-Campus Interviewing Program, we are preparing to transition in-person meetings to virtual. This will not happen until after March 30th. Career Development staff will work directly with all employers and candidates to provide alternatives utilizing our Zoom video conferencing technology or employer-provided systems. If you must cancel an interview, please let us know as soon as possible.
