John Brown University has partnered with peerTransfer™ to offer an innovative and streamlined way to make international student account payments. peerTransfer's mission is to save international students and their families money that would otherwise be lost on bank fees and unfavorable foreign exchange rates. With peerTransfer™, you are offered excellent foreign exchange rates, allowing you to pay in your home currency (in most cases) and save a significant amount of money, as compared to traditional banks. In addition, the posting of the payment into your JBU student account will be faster, and you will be notified via email when it is received.

- To get started, select the country from which funds will be coming and the payment amount in U.S. dollars (a minimum of \$50) you wish to make to your student bill.
- In most cases, the U.S. dollar amount will be converted into your home currency at preferential exchange rates, which will translate into savings for you.
- After providing some additional basic information, you will book the transaction and will be instructed via email on how to pay peerTransfer™ from your home country bank account.
- peerTransfer™ will then forward the U.S. dollar amount to John Brown University where it will be directly credited to your student billing account.
- You will receive an email to confirm receipt of payment.
- At any time, you will have a dedicated customer service team reachable via chat, Skype, email, and phone to answer any of your questions.
