

SEA Director

This position works closely with the Director of Student Engagement to help provide direction and leadership to the Student Events and Activities Officer Team by helping lead weekly meetings, managing both the SEA budget and SEA email, leading and coordinating events as needed, delegating tasks in order to effectively implement weekend programming and providing overall communication throughout the week. This position meets on a regular basis with the Director of Student Engagement for leadership development, addressing needs of the SEA team and overall management assistance.
