
Introduction

This document provides retention, persistence, graduation, and completion rates for Traditional Undergraduate, Online Undergraduate, and Graduate Students. An interactive version of this report is available from the Institutional Effectiveness page on Eaglenet.

Traditional Undergraduates (TUG)

Retention is a key issue facing John Brown University. In our previous Strategic Plan, we set a goal of a 70% graduation rate in the traditional undergraduate program. The first step to accomplishing this would be to have at least 82% of the freshman cohort retain to the second year. Since 2014, all but four cohorts hit the 82% retention mark. Our latest 6-year graduation rate cohort, the 2019 cohort had a 77% graduation rate. The purpose of this document is to show our retention and graduation rates for students with various characteristics. It is hoped that this data can help inform our intervention strategies with students to help improve their connection to JBU and, hence, their learning and persistence. For each characteristic, there is a graph of the retention rate and a graph of the graduation rate. The primary purpose of the graphs is to visualize trends over time. Following each set of retention and graduation rate graphs is a data table with initial enrollment, number of students retained, percent of students retained, number of students graduated, and percent graduated.

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
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Retention and Graduation Rates: Overall and by Gender

Note that the most recent 6-year graduation rate is from the 2018 cohort. The graphs show the 4-year and 5-year rates for the 2021 and 2020 cohorts, respectively. While transfer students are not included in the official retention and graduation rates, the number of transfer students makes a significant impact on enrollment.

Graduation Rate: Freshman Cohort 6-Year Rates for 2015-19 Cohorts; 5-year rate for 2020; 4-year rate for 2021




Graduation Rate: Transfer Cohort 6-Year Rates for 2015-19 Cohorts; 5-year rate for 2020; 4-year rate for 2021





Retention and Graduation Rates by ACT & SAT Scores: Freshman Only

We would expect greater retention for students with higher ACT and SAT scores, and the data bear that out. The data suggest that initiatives directed at students with low to mid scores (ACT 20-23 and SAT 900-1100) could help with retention. And the lowest scorers are much less likely to graduate even if they do continue for the second year.

Graduation Rate: Freshman Cohort by ACT Score






Graduation Rate: Freshman Female Cohort by ACT Score






Graduation Rate: Freshman Male Cohort by ACT Score




Graduation Rate: Freshman Cohort by SAT Score




Graduation Rate: Freshman Female Cohort by SAT Score




Graduation Rate: Freshman Male Cohort by SAT Score







Graduation Rate: Freshman Cohort by Application Date




Graduation Rate: Transfer Cohort by Application Date





Graduation Rate: Freshman Cohort by Geography




Graduation Rate: Transfer Cohort by Geography



Retention to 2nd Year: Freshman Cohort by Residence



Retention to 2nd Year: Transfer Cohort by Residence







Retention and Graduation Rates by Athletes

Retention to 2nd Year: Athletes by Sport




Retention to 2nd Year: Athletes by Freshman or Transfer

Graduation Rate: Athletes by Freshman or Transfer












Overall, Business Administration/General Business, Management, Management Accounting, Organizational Leadership





Graduation Rate: Graduate Programs


