Summer Academy Code of Conduct

Welcome! To ensure a safe, productive, and enjoyable experience, all participants must adhere to this Code of Conduct. By participating, you agree to comply with these guidelines.

All participants are expected to conduct themselves consistent with John Brown University's Christian mission and institutional commitments. Behaviors inconsistent with biblical principles, respect for others, or the university's standards will not be permitted and may result in disciplinary action.

General Expectations

- **Respect for Others:** Treat all students, staff, and faculty with kindness and respect. Bullying, harassment, or discrimination will not be tolerated.
- **Participation:** Attend all scheduled activities on time with a positive attitude.
- **Stay on Campus:** Remain on campus unless you leave with your program for a camp-sponsored event.

Dormitory Rules

- **Curfew & Room Checks:** Be in your room by 10:00 PM. Counselors will complete room checks at 10:30 PM.
- **Quiet Hours:** 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Keep noise to a minimum.
- **Room Assignments:** Stay in your assigned room. No room changes or overnight guests without staff approval.
- **Furniture & Halls:** Do not move furniture out of your room. Do not visit opposite-gender halls; use lounges for mixed-gender socializing.
- **Visitors:** Not permitted in dorm rooms unless authorized by staff. Use common areas.
- **Cleanliness:** Maintain a clean living space and avoid damaging facilities.
- **Prohibited Items:** Firearms, fireworks, candles, incense, alcohol, drugs, and other dangerous or illegal items are strictly prohibited.

Vehicles

- **No Personal Vehicles:** Keys must be left with parents/guardians or Summer Academy staff. Vehicles remain in the dorm parking lot for the program's duration.
- **Program Transportation:** Provided by the program as needed.

Conduct & Safety

- **Property Respect:** Respect all campus property. Vandalism, theft, or misuse results in disciplinary action.

- Security Cameras: In use around campus, including entrances, hallways, community spaces, and outdoors.
- No PDA: Public displays of affection are not allowed.
- Safety Compliance: Follow all campus safety rules and emergency procedures. Familiarize yourself with evacuation routes.
- Substance Use: Possession or use of alcohol, tobacco, vaping products, or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited.
- Medication: All medicines (prescribed and over-the-counter) must be turned in to the campus nurse for distribution.

Technology Use

- Device Use: Use personal devices responsibly. Do not disrupt classes, dorm life, or activities.
- Internet Etiquette: Use campus Wi-Fi responsibly. Inappropriate content, cyberbullying, or illegal online activities are forbidden.

Disciplinary Action

- Failure to comply may result in:
 - Verbal or written warnings
 - Restriction from activities
 - Removal from the program without refund
